Living in Transition?

Students ^{under 21} living in situations that are not fixed, regular, or adequate for nighttime residence may be considered *homeless* and have certain educational protections under the McKinney-Vento Act.

Students Living in Transition:

- Share housing with family or friends due to the loss of their own housing;
- Live in motels, trailer parks, or camp grounds;
- Live in a shelter;
- Have a nighttime residence that is a public or private place not intended for use as a regular sleeping accommodation for people;
- Live in cars, parks, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus stations, etc.;
- Are migratory - whose parent or guardian is a migratory worker;
- Are unaccompanied youth (including youth not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.)

How can the School District Help?

First, we need to identify students and families in transition.

Then we can help them understand their rights and provide a number of free services to help them succeed in school.
